

Sustainability Policy

Thanks to an established sustainability culture, we always aim to make the most sustainable choices. We consciously and proactively consider the effects our choices have on our ecological and social environment for the benefit of our stakeholders. We work with action plans that are clear and concrete, have measurable objectives, monitor and report progress in our Sustainability Report.

Reducing the environmental impact of our operations is an ongoing work and means that we primarily focus on emissions from our aircrafts, but also on our resource management, and our suppliers' sustainability work. Through training and information, our co-worker's competence and engagement are being maintained on a high level. This is captured by us and spread to our customers and other stakeholders.

We see climate impact as a global issue that requires coordinated international efforts in the aviation industry, for example through new technology such as new aircraft and biofuels, as well as marketing activities such as co-financing models for biofuels and fossil-free products.
